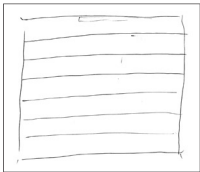

Quilting



Your way to get into it is your interest in doing it, and there are three different levels of quilting projects you can do. One beginner's quilt is you have strips that you sew together. You have got your top layer, your batting and your backing. So, you sew all the strips

together first. You sew these together and you have got your sewn side on the backs of the inside, and then when you get these all

together, your layer with the top, the batting and the backing, then you put a binding on it. To adhere this edge, you just lay it down here and sew it all the way around. Here is your quilt. You cut out an edge. This is your long edge like this and you put your edges together. Then you put it on the edge of the quilt, a quarter inch from where you sew it, and then you flip it over, and you have got to sew all along here, and then you flip it over and attach it to the back. This is one of the popular styles for beginners, and you can get different fabrics and such and sew those together, the different designs, and that is a simple way to start out. **-Marilyn Jones**
